


# Number of Reported Cases of Forcible Sexual Intercourse or Forcible Indecency

# Number of Cases Cleared for Prostitution-related Crime and Number of Women Requiring Protection

The number of cases cleared for prostitution-related crimes and the number of women requiring protection have been on a declining trend in recent years.



### Number of Cases and Persons Cleared for TIP

Since the peak year of 2005, the respective numbers of cases cleared for TIP, arrested suspects, and victims have all declined. These numbers have remained essentially level in recent years.



The number of consultations at Spousal Violence Counseling and Support Centers have been over 100,000 cases since 2014.



# Stalker Activity

#### Number of Consultations on Stalking Cases

The number of consultation and other cases related to stalker incidents fell by 1,523 cases from 21,556 cases in 2018. 87.9% of the victims were women and 82.1% of the perpetrators were men. The number of cases cleared for violation of the Anti-Stalking Act declined by 56 in 2018 to 870 cases, the first year-on-year decline since 2012.


