## Be aware.

Trafficking in persons demeans human dignity.  
It can happen anywhere.

- “Trafficking in persons” is the exploitation of humans through forced prostitution or labor which causes severe psychological and physical damage.
- Forced prostitution is a grave violation of human dignity and human rights and must never be tolerated.
- Trafficking in persons and child prostitution, whether committed in Japan or abroad, are punishable crimes.

**You can help the victims by reporting to the nearest Police Station or Immigration Office—information that can lead to their rescue.**
