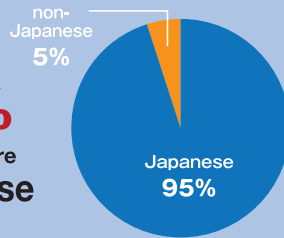


Trafficking in Persons

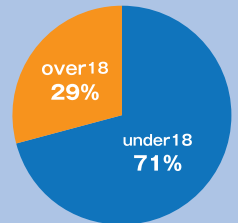
It can happen to anybody!

More than **70%**
of the victims were
under 18!

You or someone close to you might be a victim.

Your friend(or daughter) who enjoys host clubs
seems to have started working in the sex industry.



**They might have been coerced
into sex work due to heavy debt.**

Persons looking for a "sugar daddy"
or offering prostitution service on social media.



**Children might be forced
or lured into engage in sexual acts.**

Persons offering accommodation
for runaways on social media.



**They might be targeted
as victims of obscene acts.**

A foreign worker saying
"my passport has been taken away."



**They seem to be coerced to work
under exploitative conditions.**
